

MORE ABOUT THE TRAILING COMMISSION

The trailing commission is an ongoing commission. It is paid for as long as you own the Fund. It is for the services and advice that your representative and their firm provide to you.





Mulvihill Capital Management Inc. pays the trailing commission to your representative's firm. It is paid from the Fund's management fee and is based on the value of your investment. The rate for this class of the Fund is up to 1% of the value of your investment each year. This equals \$10 each year for every \$1,000 invested.



A WORD ABOUT TAX

In general, you'll have to pay income tax on any money you make on a fund. How much you pay depends on the tax laws where you live and whether or not you hold the Fund in a registered plan, such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan, or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

Keep in mind that if you hold your Fund in a non-registered account, fund distributions are included in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Class UF units of the Fund. The fees and expenses — including any commissions — can vary among classes of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

1. SALES CHARGES

You do not pay a sales charge when you buy or redeem your Class UF units.

2. FUND EXPENSES

The fund's expenses are made up of the management fee, operating expenses and trading costs. The class' annual management fee is 1.00% of the class value. As no Class UF units have been issued as of September 16, 2022, operating expenses and trading costs are not yet available.

MORE ABOUT THE TRAILING COMMISSION

The Fund does not pay a trailing commission to your representative.

3. OTHER FEES

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold or sell units of the Fund.

Fee	What You Pay
Short-term-trading fee	If you sell units of the Fund within 30 days of acquisition you may be charged a short-term trading fee up to 2% of the value of the units that you sold. This fee is paid to the Fund and is in addition to any sales charge that is payable by you to your representative's firm.
Fee-based account fee	Class UF units of the Fund are available to investors who have accounts with representative firms. Investors pay their representative firm a fee directly for investment advice or other services.
Performance fee	The Fund will pay a performance fee to Mulvihill Capital Management Inc. in any calendar quarter equal to 10% of the amount by which the adjusted net asset value per unit (which includes distributions paid or payable) at the end of such calendar quarter exceeds the performance of the blended total return of the Cboe S&P 500 BuyWrite Index (in U.S. dollars) and the S&P/TSX 60 Covered Call 2% OTM Monthly Index (in U.S. dollars) (weighted 50% as to each index).

WHAT IF I CHANGE MY MIND?

Under securities law in some provinces and territories, you have the right to:

- i) withdraw from an agreement to buy mutual funds within two business days after you receive a simplified prospectus or Fund Facts document, or
- ii) cancel your purchase within 48 hours after you receive confirmation of the purchase.
