#### Message to Unitholders

Digital World Trust began its investment operations on February 23, 2000. In the short span of four and a half months to June 30, distributions to unitholders of 85 cents per unit were generated. A good portion of this success was achieved through put option writing activity in a declining market, a more defensive investment strategy.

Within the Trust's first month of operation, the NASDAQ 100 hit a peak of 4704.73, then declined 35.7 percent to a low of 3023.42 by May 23. In this environment, option writing proved to be a lucrative source of income. While concerns persist about the market valuations of many technology companies, the long-term growth fundamentals in this sector remain intact.

Volatility in technology stocks is likely to continue for some time, and the Trust will continue to pursue its option-writing strategy to take advantage of this situation. Put options enable the Trust to acquire shares at attractive valuations during periods of market weakness.
